What type of motor is included in the 7 Quart Bowl-Lift Stand Mixer with Redesigned Premium Touchpoints (KSM70SN)?

The 7 Quart Bowl-Lift Stand Mixer with Redesigned Premium Touchpoints features a powerful universal motor driven by AC (alternating current) that offers 2x the power in the bowl than our Tilt-Head stand mixer¹.

The AC motor features a split phase control designed for high efficiency without compromising power or capability.

The KSM70SN can knead up to 8.75lbs of bread dough², mix 13 dozen cookies per batch³, or mash 7.75lbs of potatoes. The updated 7 Quart Bowl-Lift Stand Mixer with Redesigned Premium Touchpoints provides power and versatility for recipes big and small.

How powerful is the 7 Quart Bowl-Lift Stand Mixer with Redesigned Premium Touchpoints?

The 7 Quart Bowl-Lift Stand Mixer with Redesigned Premium Touchpoints carries a 500 watt power rating.

The KSM70SN can knead up to 8.75lbs of bread dough², mix 13 dozen cookies per batch³, or mash 7.75lbs of potatoes. The updated Bowl-Lift Stand Mixer with Redesigned Premium Touchpoints provides power and versatility for recipes big and small.

How does KitchenAid measure power?

KitchenAid measures power in the bowl, to deliver capacity and performance where you need it most. By focusing on practical user cases (ex. bread dough, cookies), KitchenAid allows each consumer to make an informed decision as to which mixer is right for them.



KitchenAid measures power consumed by mixers as wattage. This is done in compliance with standards published by Underwriters Laboratory (UL) and according to representative loads from those standards. The wattage measurement is intended to inform consumers on loading of their home electrical circuits and is not intended to describe power output or performance of the product under heavy loads.

Is ½ speed a new speed?

½ speed is an entirely new speed unique to the 7 Quart Bowl-Lift Stand Mixer with Redesigned Premium Touchpoints. ½ speed is twice as slow as speed 1 and brings the total number of speeds to 11.

Designed for folding, ½ speed gently adds delicate ingredients, like blueberries and egg whites, into recipes without overbeating.

What are the “Redesigned Premium Touchpoints” referred to in the product name?

With redesigned, modern accents for the next generation of the iconic stand mixer, the updated Bowl-Lift Stand Mixer with Redesigned Premium Touchpoints features diecast knobs, and updated planetary hub cover on select models.

What type of warranty is included with the 7 Quart Bowl-Lift Stand Mixer with Redesigned Premium Touchpoints (KSM70SN)?

KitchenAid stands behind all of the products we make. All KitchenAid Stand Mixers come with a minimum 1-year limited warranty⁴.
