
Measuring for Your Delivery

We want to ensure your new furniture is delivered successfully. This guide provides important measurement and obstruction information you should consider before you purchase your furniture and have it delivered.



Getting Started. Will it fit?

- ☐ Will our delivery truck fit down your road?
- ☐ Are your driveway and sidewalk clear?
- ☐ Will your driveway hold a 24-foot truck?
- ☐ Will the furniture fit through all doorways?
- ☐ Will the furniture fit up your stairway?
- ☐ Is your room ready for the product?
- ☐ Will your hallway size allow our delivery team through with product?

Apartment/Condominium Dwellers

For apartment buildings, condominiums, or homes with elevators, it is important to measure the elevator interior height, elevator opening and opposite wall distance to ensure furniture will fit. If your building has a freight elevator, please reserve it in advance.




How We Measure Your Furniture

We measure your furniture by length, width and height, as seen below, to determine how much floor and wall space your new furniture will occupy.

Measuring for Delivery

Measure the diagonal depth and width of the furniture as shown below to determine if it will fit through your home's entryways.







Sofa diagonal depth DD must be less than the entryway dimension 2, stairway dimensions 3, 4 & 8 and all interior doorways 6 or 7.

Casegoods width W must be less than entryway dimensions 1 or 2, stairway dimensions 3, 4 & 8 and all interior doorways 6 or 7.



Casegoods diagonal depth DD must be less than the entryway dimension 1, stairway dimensions 3, 4 & 8 and all interior doorways 6 or 7.

Preparing for delivery

Before purchasing your new furniture, note all important measurements and obstructions so you can ensure a successful delivery.

Before our delivery team arrives, prepare your home by doing the following:

(Please be aware that our delivery team is unable to make these or other preparations for you.)

- Secure low-hanging light fixturesSet rugs in place
- Move other furniture

- Remove doors if necessary
- Remove pictures or art
- Put pets in another room

During delivery, please inspect your furniture thoroughly and report any damage to our delivery team so we can resolve the issue promptly. Please note: we will not hoist furniture or remove windows.
